SUBJECT: Addendum 1 to Limited Evacuation Order (Order Number EV 2601) for Individuals
Affected by Wildfires

1. This memorandum serves as the first addendum to the Limited Evacuation Order (LEO) (Order Number EV 2601) dated 2 August 2026. All other provisions, terms, and authorities established in the original Limited Evacuation Order remain in full effect unless specifically modified by this addendum.
2. Evacuation Areas (Paragraph 4.c): This paragraph is amended to add the Mitre Rock Fire to the list of impacting wildfires with the same original effective date of 1 August 2026. The impacted area now applies to all evacuees residing in areas designated by State/Local/City civilian government authorities as a Level 3 Evacuation Area in the communities surrounding Fairchild AFB impacted by the Autumn Lane Fire, the Old Trails Fire, the Fairview Fire, and the Mitre Rock Fire.
3. Safe Haven Locations (Paragraph 4.d): The mileage limits for authorized safe haven locations are hereby extended. Safe haven locations are now defined as at least 5 miles but no more than 350 miles from permanent residences and should not be located inside government evacuation zones. Safe haven location must be located within the United States.
4. Allowances at Safe Haven - Lodging (Paragraph 5.d(2)(a)): The authorized expenses for commercial and nonconventional lodging (e.g., Airbnb, VRBO, etc.) are amended to explicitly include cleaning fees, parking fees, and early/late checkout fees as covered reimbursable lodging expenses. These fees must be clearly detailed and enumerated on the lodging receipts provided to allow for them to be claimed and reimbursed.
