

# Fairchild Air Force Base

Fairchild Air Force Base is comprised of the 92d Air Refueling Wing (host wing), the 141st Air Refueling Wing (Washington Air National Guard), the 336th Training Group (Air Education and Training Command), the Armed Forces Reserve Center, and 15 other tenant organizations/mission partners. Team Fairchild encompasses more than 6,500 Air Force active duty, Air National Guard, Army Guard and Reserve members, and civilian employees.



The 92d Air Refueling Wing provides air refueling, rapid and reliable passenger and cargo airlift, and aeromedical evacuation missions supporting U.S. and coalition conventional operations as well as strategic deterrence missions.

The wing employs forces globally in support of Combatant Commands, services, appropriate U.S. government agencies and allies to advance U.S. interests around the world.

As the U.S. Air Force's Super Tanker Wing, the 92d Air Refueling Wing currently has 63 KC-135 Stratotanker aircraft assigned. The KC-135 provides the core air refueling capability for the U.S. Air Force and has excelled in this role for more than 60 years. This capability provides air refueling support to Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and allied nation aircraft. The KC-135 is also capable of transporting litter and ambulatory patients during aeromedical evacuations.



These aircraft and the dedicated members of Team Fairchild actively support homeland defense, combat, and humanitarian missions.
