Fairchild Air Force Base is comprised of the 92d Air Refueling Wing (host wing), the 141st Air Refueling Wing (Washington Air National Guard), the 336th Training Group (Air Education and Training Command), the Armed Forces Reserve Center, and 15 other tenant organizations. Team Fairchild encompasses more than 6,000 Air Force Active Duty, Air National Guard, Army Guard and Reserve members, and civilian employees.



The 92 ARW provides air refueling, rapid and reliable passenger and cargo airlift, and aeromedical evacuation missions supporting U.S. and coalition conventional operations as well as U.S. Strategic Command strategic

deterrence missions. As the host of Air Mobility Command 's (AMC) 2019 flagship exercise, MOBILITY GUARDIAN '19, the 92 ARW directly supports AMC's mission, providing global reach air power and deploying expeditionary combat support forces in support of worldwide contingency requirements. The 92 ARW capability of aerial refueling enhances the Air Force's ability to accomplish its primary missions of Global Reach and Global Power.

The 92 ARW currently has 59 KC-135 Stratotanker aircraft assigned. The KC-135 provides the core aerial

refueling capability for the United States Air Force and has excelled in this role for more than 60 years. This capability provides aerial refueling support to Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and allied nation aircraft.



The KC-135 is also capable of transporting litter and ambulatory patients during aeromedical evacuations.

These aircraft and the dedicated members of Team Fairchild actively supported homeland defense, combat, and humanitarian missions throughout the world.
