


PFAS Sampling Area Near Fairchild Air Force Base

This map is provided to help residents identify whether their property is located within the current PFAS sampling area near Fairchild AFB. Sampling is part of ongoing efforts to better understand PFAS in groundwater and private drinking water wells in the surrounding community.



DO I NEED SAMPLING

If you live or operate a business within the shaded PFAS sampling area shown on this map and use a private well for drinking water, you may be eligible for sampling.

If your well has not previously been sampled, please contact the Air Force to check eligibility.

HOW SAMPLING WORKS

Sampling is voluntary and offered to eligible private drinking water wells within the sampling area.

If your location is eligible and has not been sampled, it will be added to the sampling list and tested as soon as practical.

Results will be shared with the property owner.

WHY IS SAMPLING NEEDED

PFAS are man-made chemicals that were historically used in firefighting foam and can move through groundwater. The Air Force is conducting sampling near Fairchild Air Force Base as part of an ongoing environmental investigation and in coordination with updated national drinking water standards established in 2024. Sampling helps identify private drinking water wells that may require further evaluation and follow-up.
